Let's talk Puppy 101 and what to expect...

#### 8-10 weeks of age: Eat Poop Sleep Repeat

Puppies at this age are great fun; sickeningly cute, usually small enough to carry around and they sleep a LOT. Play time will be short and usually nibbly. As owners we can build some good habits for ourselves by establishing potty routines and crate training (if desired) and lay the groundwork for the future.

### 11-13 weeks: Wild Crazy Love

By this age, puppies are becoming more aware of their surroundings and how much fun biting is. As a first time owner, this stage can be very overwhelming because the puppy is more active and testing out its environment with their teeth. Their attention span can be short but we can make good progress with obedience and manners.

#### 14 - 16 weeks: How To Dog

All things going well, this is usually the age where puppies are now able to go to the dog park and actively socialise with the wider world. This is also where we need to ensure that our puppies have good Doggy Manners, which is different to obedience.

#### 18 weeks onwards

The aim by this stage is to have a good base for recall and Doggy Manners so that you can build on your dog's skill and obedience at your own pace, in a manner that suits you and your lifestyle.

### WHAT IS THE AIM OF PUPPY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL?

To educate owners on how to understand their dog, how to read their social cues and teach Doggy Manners and general etiquette. Obedience forms the base of all of our work to ensure a strong bond between dog and owner.

### WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT FROM PUPPY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL?

#### Week 1: Private, one-on-one session at your home

Stef will be visiting you to talk about what your routine with your dog looks like, the equipment you have for them, and nutrition. We will be laying out everything that is working, isn't working and what the future can hold for you. We encourage all family members interested in the ongoing care and training of your dog to attend and ask any questions they have.

Homework: Stef will confirm that you have the appropriate equipment for your first school lesson and that your routine is ideal for what you're trying to achieve.

### Week 2: Welcome to Pawsome HQ!

You'll be joining us and three other classmates in our comfortable outdoor setting for the first group session. We will all get to know each other and find common ground in what we're experiencing from our puppies as we settle into life with them. We will be going through the basics of building our bond using obedience and learning about body language between dogs.

Homework: Three Basics Games - Look At Me, Leave It and Name Game.


### Week 3: How's it going?

While it's only been a week between classes, let's talk about our successes! We will be focusing on the little wins and fine tuning how we handle our dogs as they experience the world. We will be watching them learn from and play with each other and taking notes on what 'good dogto-dog manners' look like.

Homework: Pick & Proof - select one simple obedience trick to work on and teach your dog how to do it anywhere.

### Week 4: You made it!

While four weeks isn't a long time for us, for a puppy it's a long learning experience. Let's celebrate! This lesson will be an hour and half instead of one hour to allow for some puppy and human fun and celebrate your puppy's graduation. We will be making long term goals and helping you make them a reality.





### **HOUSE RULES**
